The marine life is spectacular, and you will see a rainbow of tropical fish, including Moorish idols and king and Cortez angelfish. These waters are particularly fertile and are home to hundreds species of fish. Throughout your excursion, the well-stocked onboard bar serves nonalcoholic beverages, but at the completion of your snorkeling, complimentary adult beverages and snacks are served. The sails are hoisted for your relaxing cruise back to the pier along the luxurious coastline.

In an area rich in pirate lore and stories of buried treasure, those who think Baja is only about Missions and cave paintings cannot afford to miss this aspect of local history. The ship is very similar to the one Thomas Cavendish used to take the Spanish treasure galleon "Santa Ana" in this very spot.
