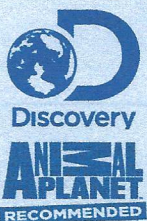

MZT-100: Best of Mazatlan



This full-day tour plus lunch that highlights Mazatlan's historic and cultural heritage is the best way to spend your day. The first photo stop of the day is the 19th century Immaculada Concepcion Cathedral in the heart of the old town. This architectural landmark, noted for its juxtaposition of Moorish and Gothic design, dominates the landscape with its twin towers and yellow domes. Continue along the coastline for views of the El Faro lighthouse. A rocky promontory is your next stop, where you'll thrill to the local cliff divers and their death-defying feats. Next stop is the resort area, The Golden Zone, where you'll disembark at the Hotel Playa. Enjoy a Mexican buffet lunch and a colorful folkloric show. Conclude your tour with a relaxing scenic drive back to the ship.

MZT-120: Concordia, Copala & Golden Zone



Embark on a full-day tour of three traditional villages. Your tour begins as your board your transportation for a scenic drive into the foothills of the rugged Sierra Madre. Your first stop is a small brick factory (if open), where you'll witness demonstrations on adobe brick making. You'll continue to the town of Concordia, founded in 1550, famed for its furniture, handmade pottery, and magnificent Baroque church. Next on your itinerary is Copala, a former gold-mining town founded in 1565. You're free to wander the narrow, cobbled streets, survey the old colonial houses and visit the 16th-century stone church. An authentic Mexican lunch is yours to enjoy, including beef or chicken fajitas, refried beans, and a Mexican pie. Your tour concludes with a brief shopping stop at the bustling Golden Zone before your return drive to the pier.

MZT-125: Mazatlan Hop On - Hop Off



Discover marvelous Mazatlan on a Hop-on/Hop-off bus tour. The bus runs approximately every 30 minutes, so you can spend as much time as you like at each of its four designated stops, reboarding when you wish. At the first stop, marvel at cliff divers who leap from a 50-foot-high platform, timing their jumps to synchronize them with the incoming waves. The second stop is Mazatlan's Historic District. Stroll through cobblestone streets and take in the restored 19th-century architecture, sidewalk cafes, and heritage sites. Then it's on to the Mazatlan Aquarium, one of the longest seafloor walkways in the world. If you choose, purchase a day pass to the aquarium and enjoy a variety of marine exhibits. Finally, arrive at the Golden Zone. Here, you will find beaches, golf courses, shops, and hotels, and more. When you are ready, reboard the bus and return to port.

MZT-205: Mazatlan City Highlights Express

This Moorish-inspired landmark houses a magnificent organ built in Paris as well as spectacular stained-glass windows. Continue to Divers Point and watch expert cliff divers' plunge fearlessly from a cliff top platform into a scant six feet of water below. Then, relax with a stroll in the Zona Dorado, or Golden Zone, the modern resort area where you can browse for souvenirs, jewelry and handicrafts amid palm lined beaches and glamorous hotels. Conclude with a relaxing scenic drive back to port.

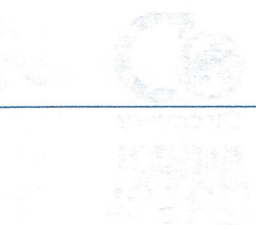
MZT-250: Local Connections: Ceviche Making with Renowned Chef and Restaurateur

Together with your guide, you'll walk along the scenic shoreline, passing Cerro de Neveria, home to Diver's Point and daring high-flying divers performing dangerous plunges into rocky surf. You'll walk into old Mazatlan, traveling the narrow streets of the historic district to Teatro Angela Peralta and past the House of Music. You'll visit the main plaza, site of the Post Office and the 19th-century Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception and City Hall. Your walking tour ends at a local restaurant to enjoy a beverage along with some chips and salsa, while waiting for the taxis transport directly to the pier. Passengers remaining in town to shop are responsible to return to the pier on their own.

MZT-400: Huana Coa Zipline Adventure



Soar over the foothills on a daylong canopy adventure. After a scenic drive to the Huana Coa Canopy Adventure base camp, you'll transfer to a classic Swiss Army Pinzgauer 6x6 vehicle and travel off-road from the valley floor into the foothills of the Sierra Madre mountain range. After receiving instruction and a safety briefing, your high-flying adventure begins. In the semi-desert tropical jungle, you'll move through a series of 12 platforms with nine ziplines and a flex-walk bridge. From the final platform, you'll embark on a nature trek to the Huana Coa base camp via Blue Agave Trail. Here, you'll enjoy a snack before departing to the Los Osuna tequila distillery, where you'll witness the transformation of blue agave into tequila, and sample the wares. Your tour concludes with drive back to the pier.

MZT-470: Panoramic Hiking Views to El Faro Lighthouse



Magnificent scenery and a legendary lighthouse greet you at the top of El Creston Hill on this energetic half-day tour. A quick ride brings you to the foot of the hill for a photo opportunity before you embark on a 30-60 minute hike. The path is a winding nature trail with spectacular indigenous flora and fauna at every turn (approximately 320 steps). Your efforts are rewarded with panoramic vistas and the delightful sight of Mazatlan's classic landmark, the El Faro Lighthouse. Perched 515 feet above the sparkling Pacific, El Faro is the highest natural working lighthouse in the world, and at night, its beam reaches over 30 nautical miles. Enjoy 45 minutes to relax, sip a complimentary beverage and photograph the panoramic vistas of the sparkling sea and your ship below. Back in the transportation; settle in for a 25-minute scenic ride that takes you past Mazatlan's Historic Downtown before returning to port.

MZT-530: Historic Mazatlán by Rhino (Seats 2)



Zip along the streets of Mazatlan on this half-day guided tour that introduces you to some of the city's most treasured sights from a 4x4 mini Jeep Rhino. After a brief safety presentation, climb into your 2-seater Jeep and set off and up to the top of Vigia ("lookout") Hill. The views are spectacular of the coastline and the famed El Faro lighthouse in the distance. Descend to admire the cliff divers' performance before heading into Old Mazatlan, the city's historic district, for visits to the exceptional 19th-century cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. Continue on to the Angela Peralta Theater, a true cultural treasure recently restored to its brilliance from the 1800s. After cruising the narrow streets and taking in a plethora of heritage sites and getting back to the pier. Hop on a van or bus and visit the Zona Dorado, or Golden Zone, a modern resort area where you can browse for souvenirs.
