Afterwards, a brief ride will take you back to the downtown district for shopping. Look through your pictures as you enjoy the relaxing ride back to the pier.

Take a high-speed launch to a remote beach where you'll ride a 4WD or a van and then a mule to your destination far inside the forest where you'll ford streams and toboggans, rappel down waterfalls, zipline high above the treetops on this all-day excursion. This active excursion takes place in a remote region that's remained pristine and unspoiled, with both scenic beauty and diverse ecological habitat for a true tropical paradise. Outfitted with helmet and harness, you'll splash through streams, trek on a forest hike, rappel through waterfalls into natural river pools, and soar 200 feet above the ground over the jungle foliage on a series of ziplines. Once back at base camp, we'll change into dry clothes and enjoy a snack before returning back to the ship.

Beginners will be given a test drive to ensure everyone feels secure, and the adventure begins! You'll ride in single file through a wide array of scenery from mountain top to riverbeds. At the halfway point, we'll stop for a rest room break before continuing on back to the base camp. Here, you can wash up, and you'll have 30 minutes of free time to sample a snack at the restaurant or relax in a hammock beneath the giant trees, before returning to the ship.

The waters are also home to a plentiful dolphin population. Your 2.5 hours spent on the ocean is ample time to relax and take in the natural wonders of the waters.
